



Our clinic's mental health and AODA staff works with our on-site physician and a variety of community based physicians to prescribe appropriate medications. By working with these doctors, we

are able to offer Suboxone® and Vivitrol® treatment programs through our Alarus Living Free Program™.

AODA (Alcohol and Other Drug Addictions) and IOP Treatment

Our alcohol and drug abuse services help people struggling with substance abuse, substance dependence, gambling and



other addictions. Services are also offered for persons with OUI and other legal issues and for those who need a Drivers Safety Plan.

Counseling session can be individual, group or a combination of both. For individuals with more severe problems, we also offer an Intensive Outpatient Program (IOP).

AODA counseling at Alarus covers the entire scope of your life. We see you as more than a person with substance abuse or addiction issues. We look at the emotional, developmental, physical, psychological, family, and social issues that you may face. We also explore the issues and challenges that your family confronts.
